The Eden Project, which was opened in the year 2000, is a living plant museum in the countryside in the south-west of England. It is a very popular attraction for visitors who come every year to see plants from all over the world growing in this special environment.

Some plants grow outside, but many are in specially-built domes, called 'biomes', where the temperature and humidity are carefully controlled. The biomes are like giant greenhouses and one, the Humid Tropics biome, is the largest greenhouse in the world. It is over 55m high and 200m long and contains many thousands of exotic plants not found in England.

There are two purposes of the project: the first is to show how dependent human beings are on plants, and the second is to educate people on the importance of preserving our natural environment. Aside from the plant life, the Eden Project has fascinating interactive exhibits for people of all ages. Many of the visitors are groups of school children. The Eden Project combines educational value with scientific interest and a huge variety of spectacular plant life.
